Right to return: Returnees from Wanni are from a different a range of background and the status as IDP has to be restrained. 2. Youngsters getting into boats in Eastern coast is a big issue 3. Ex-combatants: It was said that young combatants who were from Karuna fiction has been left out and not gone through any reintegration programme. The numbers are unknown.
