<p>Danish Red Cross</p>	<p>Psychosocial Support Project: Activities during the week</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meeting with each group of PSP volunteers in each of the four divisions. PSP volunteers who participated the Jaffna PSP training were very pleased with the training. PSP activities will be increased to four days pr. week at minimum and four hours pr. day at minimum. Activities will be expanded, adults and elderly more involved. PSP volunteers will be participating together with the people of the welfare centers in establishing community centers. Some of the PSP volunteers are in charge of the building/establishment. • Community centers: DS in Kinniya has given permission for a center in Fazar Nahar village where Japanese Red Cross will build 105 temporary shelters. PSP volunteers from Kinniya have started the process. They visited the community center in Nilaveli for information gathering. The PSP volunteers in Muthur who are involved in planning and establishing center in Nadathivu visited the center in Nilaveli as well. The process in Nadathivu has been slowed down because of protests within the camp against the respective organization in charge. • Visits to welfare centers: Seenaveli in Muthur East, Punahar in Eachilampatai, Gopalapuram and Iqbal Nagar in Kuchaveli. • Arrangement of purchasing 1000 bicycles for school children. It turned out that they are not available in Trincomalee. But the DRC financial delegate has managed to purchase Lumala bicycles in Colombo. • Meeting at Zonal education Office regarding the teacher's basic PSP training. The training was cancelled last week because of Hartal and holidays. The training will take place for six groups next Sunday. The recently created Evaluation form has been translated to Tamil and will be used. • Ongoing planning of basic PSP training for teachers in Muthur, Eachilampathai and Kinniya. • More toy items handed out to PSP volunteers in Kuchaveli. 		<p>02/06/05</p>
