The evaluations team activities: Group Discussions with PSP volunteers in Muthur and then with PSP volunteers in Kuchaveli. Focus Group Discussions with: Parents in Kuchaveli, children in Kuchaveli, PSP volunteers from Kinnyia. Interviews: Chairman of the branch, BEO, SPC, PSP coordinator, PSP delegate, the person in charge of CENT (Community Empowerment Network of Trincomalee) core group. Visits to welfare center in Eachilampathai and another in Kuchaveli. • 12 volunteers and PSP coordinator of the branch are getting PSP training in Jaffna. • Basic PSP training for Primary School Teachers teaching 1st to 5th grades has started. 10 training courses were given during the week for different groups of 25 – 30 teachers each. The training is done in cooperation with the Zonal Director of Education Trincomalee. • Sri Lanka Country Coordinator from the Danish Red Cross, Anette Cramer visited Trincomalee.
