## What do CHA Resource Centres have

Printed and non-printed resource materials such as books, reports, research papers, directories, and CD-ROMs have been made available at all the Resource Centres. In addition, more than 50 titles of leading periodicals, magazines, newsletters and newspaper articles are also available.

Peace and Conflict, Human Rights, Landmines, Internally Displaced Persons and Refugees, Disaster Management, Psychology, Disabilities, Development and more.

Establishing solid networks with humanitarian and non-humanitarian organisations, Coordination Meetings, Joint Publications, Repository System, Inter Library Loan System and Technical Support on Information Management System and/or Library and Information Science.
