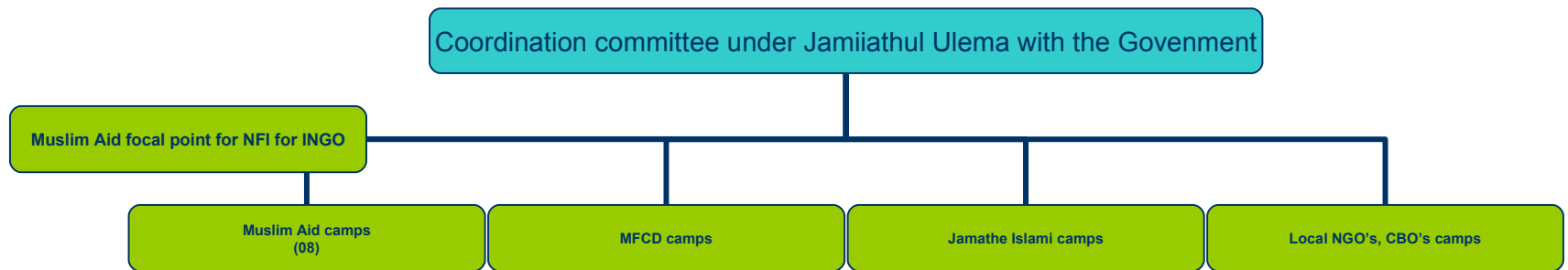
Updated statistics

- 21 camps in Kanthale, Mullipothana and Kinniya
- Estimated 44000 IDP's
- Appx 10,100 families
- Injured – 288
- Pregnant mothers- 815
- Feeding mothers – 1107

Main Issues

- Overcrowded camps of Kanthale
- Reluctance of the IDP's to go to Kinniya
- IDP's not registered with camps are increasing
- Double entries in figures
- Reluctance to accept “some” INGO aid
- Security concerns

The Needs

- Watsan issues
- Registration process
- NFI – Family pack, Baby packs, Pregnant mothers pack

Future plan

- Plans for maintaining the camps for 3 months minimum
- Resettlement plans
- Relocation plans
- Muslim Aid is willing to form partnerships with concerned NGO's for a speed recovery for the IDP's of Mutur
