Jaffna	<p>Quality of water given to people in transitional shelters is very poor.</p> <p>CHA –CPRP District Representative has discussed with Water Board reps, who will contact Urban Council and ask them to conduct tests through PHIs</p> <p>-Meeting on Permanent Housing Construction Delays was held at the Jaffna District Secretariat on October 6th.</p> <p>CHA will observe the progress in housing and organize a workshop to facilitate those who are showing slow progress by getting feed back from fast progressing Donors like UNHabitat</p>

Hambantota	<p>Ambalantota Divisional Coordination Meeting:</p> <p>50 families making their living by Paddy Farming (150 acres) at Madawinna yaya, and Watawala yaya. Seawater has come into paddy lands following the tsunami, making cultivation impossible.</p> <p>Water supply inadequate for transitional shelters in Welipatanwila. Currently water is supplied only two days a week.</p> <p>Supply for one more day needed.</p> <p>For Kalametiya fisheries harbour the following are needed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 20 lagoon/traditional crafts - 18 beach seine crafts with instruments - 7 engines of 15 horsepower - 18 engines of 25 horsepower
